Dear Parent / Carer,

As we approach the end of another school year, I just wanted to thank you all for your continued support. It has been a very busy year and we are incredibly proud of our pupils and their many achievements.

There have been many highlights including; our Key Stage productions, sporting events and numerous visits. Our most recent successes include: the school brass band winning the Martyn Evans Shield for the 'most outstanding brass band performance' at the Oldham Music Festival; our Year 3 pupils qualifying for the finals of the Primary Engineer Project and our Year 6 pupils winning third place in the Oldham Business Challenge with their company 'Crayon Creations'.

Pupils have also been involved in charity fundraising this term. Our Year 6 Business Challenge team have so far raised £550 for Cancer Research (the final total to be announced during leavers' assembly), whilst our Year 5 pupils, who wanted to raise money for the We Love Manchester Emergency Fund, raised a fantastic £260.74.

I am also pleased to inform you that we have been able to appoint a new member of staff.
