

Delph Primary School School Uniform List

Updated June 2016



School uniform consists of:

Boys

- Grey school trousers (long or short)
- Plain white school shirt, or white/grey or red polo shirt (with logo or plain)
- Red School Sweatshirt or Fleece (with logo or plain)
- Black pumps for inside/P.E.
- Dark coloured school shoes

Girls

- Grey school skirt or pinafore dress or grey school trousers
- Plain white school shirt, or white/grey or red polo shirt (with logo or plain)
- In summer, girls may wear red school summer dress
- Red School Sweatshirt, Cardigan or Fleece (with logo or plain)
- White or grey long/short socks or grey/red tights
- Black pumps for inside/P.E.
- Dark coloured school shoes

P.E. Kit

For indoor use:

- Plain white T-shirt (or white with logo)
- Navy blue shorts
- Black pumps

For outdoor use: (KS2 Children Only)

- Pair of trainers
- Tracksuit or joggers, T-shirt & sweatshirt.

For swimming lessons:

- Swimming costume or trunks (long, baggy shorts are not permitted)
- Towel
- Swimming bag
- Long hair must be tied back or swimming cap worn

Note: P.E. kit should be kept in school in a small bag, so that it is always available.

**Any other clothing, which falls outside our uniform policy is unacceptable for school.
Please ensure that all items of school uniform are clearly labelled with your child's name.**

Black pumps, pump bags and book bags are available to buy from the school office.

Jewellery

In the interests of safety, children are only permitted to wear stud earrings and a watch to school. These will have to be removed for all PE, swimming and sports sessions. No other jewellery will be allowed. Should this happen, children will be requested to remove them and the items will be kept securely and returned at the end of the school day.

We advise that ear piercing only takes place during the longer holidays, to allow for healing and to prevent children missing P.E, sports and swimming sessions.
